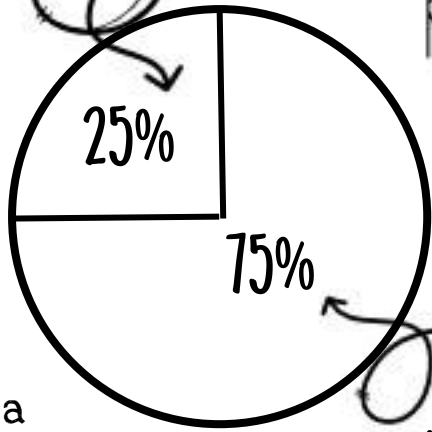
ABOUT me
